

First Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from person in center. Steps to position of platform and hold candle and end of wand in front of face.)

Christian, lend thy light
That all the world might see
The gift of love from God above,
God's Son who set men free.

Second Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from First speaker. Takes loose end of First Speaker's wand and placing it to the end of her own wand, hold it with candle at center of chest)

Christian lend they light
That all men may behold
The gifts the Wisemen brought that night,
Myrrh, frankincense and gold.

Third Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from First speaker. First speaker takes loose end of Third speaker's wand and, placing the ends together, hold it with own wand and candle in front of face. Third speaker holds other end of

own wand with candle at cent of chest)

Christian lend thy light;

It may be some will see

The light of Christ so purely

Shine forth from you and me.

Fourth Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from Second speaker. Takes loose end of Second speaker's wand, and, placing it against end of own wand, holds it with lighted candle slightly above waist.)

Christian lend thy light

It's God's command to you

To go into the whole wide world

And give His message true.

Fifth Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from third speaker. Third speaker takes loose end of fifth Speaker's wand. Fifth Speaker takes other end of wand and holds it with candle slightly above waist)

Christian, lend thy light
Let your standard be unfurled,
And spread the blessed gospel
Through all the dying world.

Sixth Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from fourth speaker. Takes loose end of fourth speaker's wand and placing it against end of own wand, wand, kneels holding it with candle at center of chest)

Christian, lend your light
What an honor it will be
To have a part in this great plan
Made sure at Calvary

Seventh Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from fifth speaker. Takes loose end of fourth speaker's wand and holds it against own. Seventh Speaker takes other end of own wand and kneeling, holds it with candle at center of chest.)

Christian, lend thy light
It's the least that you can do
When God above in his great love
Has done so much for you.

Eighth Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from sixth shepherd. Takes loose end of Sixth Speaker's wand and, placing it against end of own wand, kneels, holding it with candle at waist.)

Christian lend thy light
I pray thee-do not wait.
The midnight hour is almost here
When it will be too late.

Tenth
~~Ninth~~ Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from Seventh Speaker. Seventh Speaker takes end of Ninth Speaker's wand and holds it against own. Ninth speaker holds other end of own wand, kneels, and holds end with candle at waist)

Christian, lend thy light!
That all may see afar
That we've presented here tonight
The blessed Christmas star.

Ninth
~~Tenth~~ Speaker

(Recites while lighting candle from eighth Speaker. Takes loose end of Eighth Speaker's wand and kneels in front of manger facing audience. Holds ends of wand together with candle in front of face. Ninth Speaker's takes loose end of Tenth's Speaker wand.)

Christian, lend thy light
Your path will brighter grow,
It's beams will cheer the darkest path
It's hope to others show.

Eleventh Speaker

Fear not to lend of thy light,
Ye shall not suffer loss!

(Picks up cross and holds it above manger)

For even o'er the manger hung
The shadow of the cross.

There is a glorious light
Coming down from God above
Into the lowly manger bed:
The light of God's great love.

From Calvary if shineth forth
And beckons all mankind,
Come, lay your burdens at His feet,
And peace and joy you'll find.
